

**2017 Enplanement Projection**  
**March 9, 2017**

**Quick Notes**

- BZN projected to enplane a record 587,410 passengers in 2017, up 6.0% over 2016. Total passengers (enplaned + deplaned) are expected to surpass 1,170,000.
- American's entrance to the market with Dallas/Ft. Worth service continues to expand and with the addition of seasonal Chicago service will add an additional 23,000 seats to the market.
- Alaska, and United both project growth in the 11-15% range during 2017.
- Delta, Allegiant Air and Frontier expected to maintain historical service and passenger levels.
- BZN has non-stop service to 15 destinations throughout the United States.

Based on current projections, we anticipate that BZN will enplane approximately 587,410 passengers in 2017 which would be another record. The projected 6.0% growth represents an increase of 33,376 enplanements over 2016. (Roughly equivalent to what we expect to enplane in the month of April)

Calendar year 2016 enplanements surpassed the previous record set in 2015 by 42,557 passengers (the highest net passenger gain in our history) and was 12,501 passengers more than Airport management projections. The increase came primarily due to four positive air service developments during 2016. These developments included the addition of American and Dallas service, United's expansion of Chicago, San Francisco and Denver service, Alaska expanding their Portland service and the addition of Delta service to Seattle (although this has now been substantially reduced).

Significant factors that will positively impact BZN in 2017 include extended and upgauged service by American to Dallas/Ft. Worth (167% more seats), seasonal service to Chicago by American and expanded United service to Chicago (37% more seats) and expanded service to Portland by Alaska (49% more seats). The primary factor that will negatively impact enplanements is Delta reducing seats in the Seattle market (15% less seats in the market).

We hope these projections by airport management will give some guidance for calendar year 2017 expectations.
